

Shire of Northam Residential Waste and Tip Passes

Tip Passes are available from the gatehouse entrance of both Waste Management Facilities. Proof of property ownership and identification is required to obtain an annual pass.

The tip pass allows residents 10 free general domestic waste disposals and unlimited clean green waste disposals per year. Cars, utilities, vans and trailers bringing waste into the sites must not exceed 1.8 m x 1.2 m x 0.6 m. All loads greater in size will incur the standard waste disposal fees.

Please note costs will apply for the disposal of some wastes including asbestos, tyres, more than 30L of waste oil, animal bodies, commercial waste, and residential waste loads exceeding 1.8m x $1.2m \times 0.6 m$.

All wastes that have a charge associated with their disposal must be paid for at the gatehouse of the site before exiting. Please note there are EFTpos facilities available at the Old Quarry Road Waste Management Facility only.

Commercial Waste

All commercial waste brought to Shire Waste Management Facilities is subject to Council's standard fees and charges. Please note all waste transported from the Perth Metropolitan regional Scheme (MRS) Area is required to pay the Department of Environment and Conservation (DEC) Levy, additional to the Shire of Northam's normal waste disposal fees.

The Shire of Northam can offer the service of an account for large operators. All accounts must be applied for and approved before any waste will be accepted under the terms of an account holder. Please note administration fees may apply to the account service.

Waste Management Facilities

Liquid Waste Disposal

The Shire of Northam's Old Quarry Road Waste facility also has the ability to accept septage waste from leach drains and grease traps to its four lined ponds located at the rear of the landfill site.

Please note all septage waste is subject to the Department of Environment and Conservation Controlled Waste Regulations and must only be transported by a licensed contractor.

Recycling at Waste Management Facilities

The Shire of Northam offers a range of free recycling options at both waste facilities to its residents. These include:

Using your Bins

BIN PLACEMENT

To assist waste and recycling operators in servicing your bin on collection day:

 Bins should be placed within .5 metres of the road kerb by 6.00am on collection day, with the handles facing towards the property, without the bin blocking footpaths or driveways.



- Place your yellow recycling bin about a metre from the green bin to allow clear access for the side loading service vehicle's grab arm.
- Please do not overfill your bin as the rubbish and recycling trucks'
 hydraulics cannot lift bins weighing over 70kg, or those overfull
 with the lid open. Hot or burning ash, liquid wastes, oil, paint,
 solvents or heavy materials should not be placed in your bin as they
 may damage the bin, waste collection vehicle and the environment.
- Your bin lid must close so that the contents do not spill when it is lifted or the lid does not blow open causing street litter.
- Place your bin clear of parked cars, trees, poles, etc to allow clear access to the service vehicles.
- Only waste placed inside the bin will be collected.

HANDY HINTS

- Return bins to your property as soon as possible.
- Store bins in a shaded area.
- Clean bins regularly.

In the **yellow-topped bin** you can place;

All plastic
All metal
All glass, even broken glass
All paper



The **green-topped bin** is for **household waste**, such as kitchen scraps and garden clippings, which can be composted, just like a home compost bin

Contents from your yellow-topped bin, collected fortnightly, are sorted and baled at the RRRC and sold for reprocessing.

Items should be LOOSE (not in plastic bags) and rinsed.

This includes:

- ✓ All glass, even broken glass.
- All plastic containers (empty), including salad dressing, tomato sauce, condiment bottles & empty plastic bags.
- ✓ All cans & tins including aerosol cans & tin foil.
- All paper products including glossy magazines & pizza boxes.

YOUR WASTE BIN (GREEN-TOPPED)

Contents from your waste bin (green-topped), collected weekly, are disposed at a landfill site.

Try to keep organic waste out of your green-topped bin as it causes greenhouse gases, such as methane. You could try composting or worm farming at home. Visit recycleright.net.au for fact sheets about worm farming and composting.

× NO Glass

(ALL glass goes in your recycling bin (yellow-topped).

- X NO Batteries. Place batteries into community Battery Disposal Bins.
- X NO Hazardous Waste: petrol, gas cylinders, paints, motor oils & fluids, garden chemicals & poisons, pool chemicals, cleaners, acids, bleaches & ammonia, medicines & flammable liquids. Drop off Hazardous Waste to Toodyay Waste Transfer Station.
- X NO Medical wastes or needles.
- X NO construction, demolition & building materials (no bricks, sand, soil, concrete, rocks or asbestos).

Residential Bulk Bin Services

Northam Town Residential Properties

Council provides a 'free' skip bin for 1 week per financial year in the Northam Townsite. Skip bins are required to be booked with the Avon Waste on 9641 1318 at least 2 weeks in advance and normally dropped off to the property on a Tuesday and collected the following Tuesday.

These bins are only for domestic house hold junk only. **NO** hot or burning ashes, bricks, rocks and soil, paints, solvents, liquid waste or hazardous material are to be disposed of in these bins.
