BRIEF

The Shire of Northam Local Emergency Management Arrangements (LEMA) are to ensure the community is prepared to deal with the identified emergencies should they arise. It is not the intent of this document to detail the procedures for Hazard Management Authorities (HMA) in dealing with an emergency. These should be detailed in the HMAs' individual plans. Furthermore:

- This document applies to the local government district of the Shire of Northam
- This document covers areas where the Shire of Northam provides support to HMAs in the event of an incident:
- This document details the Shire of Northam capacity to provide resources in support of an emergency, while still maintaining business continuity; and the Shire of Northam responsibilities in relation to recovery management.

These arrangements are to serve as a guide to be used at the local level. Incidents may arise that require action or assistance from district, state or federal level.

BACKGROUND / DETAILS

These LEMA has been produced and issued under the authority of the S. 41(1) of the <u>Emergency Management Act 2005</u>, which require endorsement by the Shire of Northam Local Emergency Management Committee (LEMC) and by

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the Shire of Northam. The Shire of Northam LEMA are also noted by the Wheatbelt District Emergency Management Committee (DEMC) and State Emergency Management Committee (SEMC)

These Arrangements must be read in conjunction with the Emergency Management Act 2005, State Emergency Management Plans (WESTPLAN) and State Emergency Management Policy Statements.

- contact lists are reviewed and updated quarterly;
- a review is conducted after training that exercises the arrangements;
- an entire review is undertaken every five (5) years, as risks might vary due to climate, environment and population changes; and
- circumstances may require more frequent reviews.
