

Restricted Burning Period

The Shire of Northam wishes to advise that due to changing weather conditions, the Restricted Burning Period will commence on Monday 11th March 2019 under the following restrictions,

- All burning restricted to agricultural purposes only.
- All properties must be 40ha and above to be eligible to apply for a permit.
- All burning is restricted to grass/stubble only, no solid fuels are to be burnt during the restricted period.

Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 24G (2) of the Bush Fires Act 1954, the Shire of Northam also prohibits the burning of all 1m3 piles of garden refuse/rubbish on the ground or in an incinerator that would otherwise be permitted under Section 24F within its district during this Restricted Period.

All garden refuse/rubbish should be taken to the tip or disposed of in another manner, other than burning.

This prohibition applies to **all** persons within the Shire of Northam district.
