



Industry Attraction Fund Leveraged Funding Opportunities

There are a wide range of potential State and Federal Government grants that businesses may be eligible for and could be utilised towards the \$5m cash contribution required under the Industry Attraction Fund guidelines or to assist with operational costs. Listed here are some examples of potential grants and locations where grants can be found as funding rounds open. Any applicant should undertake their own research into other opportunities and the suitability of any grants listed here. Not all the grants listed here are currently open, however applicants can contact agencies directly to seek advice on anticipated opening dates, with some grants have varying industry or geographic foci for each round.

The federal website business.gov.au provides a listing of many grants available, including a wide range of Western Australian Government grants. Note that currently the Western Australian government does not use a centralised system for listing grants, with not all grants appearing on business.gov.au. It is worth applicants researching industry specific grants by connecting with the government agencies that are responsible for their industry (for example, agriculture related development should seek advice from Department of Primary Industries & Regional Development), with a view to understanding grant opportunities, as well as the potential to present a stand-alone business case for funding where the development has strong outcomes connected with the relevant agency's priorities.
