The Shire of Northam Aboriginal & Environmental Interpretive Centre is a partnership project involving the Shire of Northam, Northam Aboriginal Community, Australian Federal Government, Lotterywest and the WA Government.

The aim of the project is to celebrate Aboriginal Culture and the Environment in the region whilst providing an International standard visitor attraction.

2. Major tasks Completed In April

Site establishment, including amenities, site fencing, and temporary services.

- Ground compaction.
- Lower Level steelwork shop drawings
- Upper Level cast-in plate shop drawings
- Groundwork, slab preparation and footings formation, including placement of termite barriers.
- Concrete pour to Viewing Bay footings, to Den Refurbishment ground slab, and to fence post piles.
