#### 1. Project Information

The Shire of Northam Aboriginal & Environmental Interpretive Centre is a partnership project involving the Shire of Northam, Northam Aboriginal Community, Australian Federal Government, Lottery West and the WA Government.

The aim of the project is to celebrate Aboriginal Culture and the Environment in the region whilst providing an International standard visitor attraction.

The project has two main elements, the construction of the building, subject of this update and the development of the interpretation which will be the 'soul' of the centre.
