

# Recreation Facilities Development Review

## Project Overview

The current Recreation Facilities Development Plan was developed and implemented in August 2016 addressing community needs for the period to 2031. To ensure the continuity of the plan, it has been resolved to undertake a review to ensure that the plan continues to align with industry trends and community expectations.

The Review will be assessing existing infrastructure and its utilisation, and will provide a strategic asset management framework that will guide any maintenance, planning, design and renewal of community recreation infrastructure that is essential to deliver the Shire's future community vision.

The Shire of Northam believes recreation and community facilities are essential to the ongoing development and wellbeing of our community, and as such the development of a management strategy is vital in ensuring that limited resources are allocated appropriately to meet the needs of the Shire of Northam community. To develop the strategy and action plan, six key stakeholder groups will be consulted, including end-users of our facilities.
