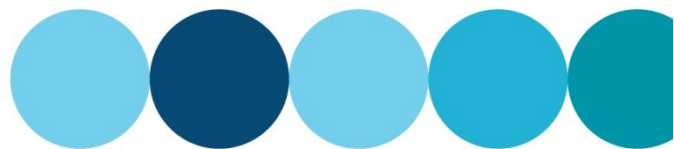

Suburban Rd pump station upgrades

Project Update

Water Corporation and our contractors Valmec have begun work to upgrade the wastewater pump station on **Suburban Road in Northam** (corner of Suburban Rd and Mudalla Rd). The work will expand the emergency storage capacity of the pump station and increase its ability to keep up with flows during significant wet weather events.



What have we done?

In July 2021, 80kL of above ground emergency wastewater storage was installed at the pump station site. This is temporary and will be removed upon completion of the project.

To allow ground works to begin at the pump station, preliminary site remediation was required. The remediation however was delayed due to wet weather, which has subsequently delayed commencement of construction works.

Remediation works on site are now complete and site construction can now proceed as planned.



What is happening next?

The electrical and mechanical upgrades will now **commence in late March 2022**.

Following this, installation of additional emergency storage tanks and associated infrastructure will commence in May 2022 and is scheduled to **finish during August 2022**.

All work will be confined to the wastewater pump station site.

How will this impact me?

During this time you may notice increased activity and noise in the area surrounding the pump station. There will be no interruptions to your water supply or wastewater services.

Minor traffic management may be required at times to allow vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists to proceed safely around the work area.

Towards the **end of July** the wastewater **pump station will go offline for 3-4 days** while new equipment is connected. Wastewater will be transported to the treatment plant by tanker trucks, 24 hours per day during this period. There may be increased activity and noise associated with the works and tankering during this period, including outside of normal works hours. The tankering route is shown on the map on page 1. We will notify immediately adjacent landowners prior to this occurring.

We appreciate your patience and understanding whilst we undertake this important work.
