1. DECLARATION OF OPENING AND WELCOME

5. CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

Moved Cr Letch Seconded Cr Beazley The minutes of the meeting held on 8 April 2009 were accepted. Carried.

6. AGENDA ITEMS

- 6.1 Bernard Park Sound Shell The Committee discussed the proposed Sound Shell design in particular the following:
 - 6.1.1 Having the rear mostly open, but able to be closed in during events
 - 6.1.2 It was suggested that several concepts be put out for public comment for discussion at the next meeting. After that feedback has been received, the Committee may be in a position to invite Architects to the next meeting.

1. That a number of Sound Shell designs (4) be put out for public comment before next Committee meeting.

- 6.2 Wundowie Hall proposed addition The Committee considered a proposal from Silver Wings Wundowie for an addition to the Wundowie Hall, consisting of a meeting room and storage, to provide them a permanent space. Silver Wings have over 100 members. It was suggested that staff investigate the availability of external funding to help with this kind of proposal. Also the YAC building or old Wundowie Fire Station may be available, since although Council's long-term view is to sell YAC property, the purchase agreement (with Lotteries Commission who paid for half ie \$15,000 of the property) states that it must be kept for 10 years for the charitable uses (expires November 2013).
- 6.3 Proposal from Heritage Council for heritage listing of old Northam Fire Station The Committee was opposed to putting the building on the State Heritage List. The Committee also questioned whether the building is underutilised, and whether its current functions (storage, meetings and Avon Descent Annual Competitor registrations) could be split and relocated to other buildings.

Moved Gill Beazley, Seconded Michael Letch

- 2. That Council is opposed to listing on the State Heritage Register the old Northam Fire Station (Avon Descent Building) at 87 Duke Street Northam since it wasn't the original Northam Fire Station, but is willing to list the building on the Heritage Council's 'Places Database'.
 - 6.4 Visitor's Centre proposed Licensing, Rivers Edge Café use Several Committee members visited the Visitor's Centre to consider whether Council's Licensing function should be relocated to that building, and also the best use of the Rivers Edge Café and Migrant Exhibition Room. Since the Visitor's Centre Report is not available at this point in time, the Committee felt it was premature to make any recommendations on these matters.
 - 6.5 Possible surplus buildings and land assets in the Shire which could be disposed of to help fund new building assets (President request). A shortlist was developed, for further consideration by Council in the future. The exact details of freehold lots in town is contained in a file in the Manager of Planning & Development's office.
