

4 DISCLOSURE OF INTERESTS

As defined in section 5.60A of the Local Government Act 1995, a **financial interest** occurs where a Councillor / Committee Member, or a person with whom the Councillor / Committee Member is closely associated, has a direct or indirect financial interest in the matter. That is, the person stands to make a financial gain or loss from the decision, either now or at some time in the future.

As defined in section 5.61 of the Local Government Act 1995, an **indirect financial** interest includes a reference to a financial relationship between that person and another person who requires a Local Government decision in relation to the matter.

As defined in section 5.60B of the Local Government Act 1995, a person has a **proximity interest** in a matter if the matter concerns a proposed change to a planning scheme affecting land that adjoins the person's land; or a proposed change to the zoning or use of land that adjoins the person's land; or a proposed development (as defined in section 5.63(5)) of land that adjoins the person's land.

As defined in clause 22 of the Local Government (Model Code of Conduct) Regulations 2021, an **impartiality interest** means an interest that could, or could reasonably be perceived to, adversely affect the impartiality of the person having the interest and includes an interest arising from kinship, friendship or membership of an association.

6.2 Training Opportunities

The Committee to discuss any potential training or professional development opportunities for the Chief Executive Officer to undertake in 2024/25, noting that the current Chief Executive Officer's contract specifies in Item 11(a) of Schedule 2 a \$5,000 per year Professional Development benefit.

The specific clause in the Chief Executive Officer's contract in relation to Professional development reads as follows:

6.5.1 In this clause, "conference" includes workshop, forum or similar event.

6.5.2 The Local Government:

(a) supports, as part of Your performance of the Functions, Your attendance at conferences; and

(b) must pay the costs associated with Your attendance at conferences, relevant to Your performance of the Functions, up to a maximum amount specified in Item 11(a) of Schedule 2.

6.5.3 In addition, where the Council (or, if the Council so resolves, the President) believes that it is in the interests of the Local Government, the Local Government may also pay the costs of other conference attendances by You for purposes relevant to the Functions.

In July 2024, the Chief Executive Officer attended the National General Assembly of Local Government at a cost of \$3,638 (registration fee, travel and accommodation). The Chief Executive Officer is also registered to attend the WALGA Conference on 9 and 10 October 2024 at a cost of \$1,295. This expenditure applies to the first year of professional development under the contract being 16 October 2023 to 16 October 2024.

Another \$5,000 professional development benefit will become due from 17 October 2024.
