As defined in section 5.60B of the Local Government Act 1995, a person has a **proximity interest** in a matter if the matter concerns a proposed change to a planning scheme affecting land that adjoins the person's land; or a proposed change to the zoning or use of land that adjoins the person's land; or a proposed development (as defined in section 5.63(5)) of land that adjoins the person's land.

As defined in clause 22 of the Local Government (Model Code of Conduct) Regulations 2021, an **impartiality interest** means an interest that could, or could reasonably be perceived to, adversely affect the impartiality of the person having the interest and includes an interest arising from kinship, friendship or membership of an association.

#### A. BACKGROUND / DETAILS

The next Local Government ordinary elections are being held on 18 October 2025. In preparation for this election, the WA Electoral Commission (WAEC) is seeking information from local governments with respect to whether it wishes them to be responsible for the conduct of the election.

The proposal from the WAEC in Attachment 13.1.3.1 and 13.1.3.2 is based on 4 vacancies across the 3 wards. There will be 5 Council Members up for election. As determined in the Ward and Representation Review finalised in 2023 however, the East Ward will reduce from 6 to 5 Council Members at the 2025 Local Government ordinary elections.

The written agreement has been issued by the WAEC and is provided in Attachment 13.1.2.3. In accordance with the Local Government Act 1995, Council is required to declare that the Electoral Commissioner be responsible for the elections and decide that this be held as a postal election, which is consistent with the conduct of the Shire's elections in previous years.

The estimated cost for the 2025 election if conducted as a postal ballot is \$53,395 excluding GST. This is an increase of \$4,795 (exc. GST) from the 2023 Local Government ordinary elections.

#### Cost Estimate Letter: 2025 Local Government Ordinary Election

As you are aware, the next local government ordinary election will be held on 18 October 2025. This letter is your Cost Estimate for the Western Australian Electoral Commission to conduct your election, should you proceed with making a declaration under the *Local Government Act 1995* for us to do so.

#### Cost Estimate

The Commission has estimated the cost to conduct your Council's election in 2025 as a postal election at approximately \$53,395 (ex GST).

This cost has been based on the following assumptions:

- The method of election will be postal;
- 4 Councillor(s) vacancies;
- 8500 electors;
- response rate of approximately 40%
- · appointment of a local Returning Officer; and
- count to be conducted at your office using CountWA.

If any of these assumptions are not correct, please contact us and we can provide a new cost estimate.

#### Cost Methodology

To provide your estimate, the Commission has estimated the costs of all aspects of the election, from supply of materials to staffing costs. For the 2025 Local Government elections, we have applied the following apportionment across the State:



For individual local Governments the exact apportionment of costs may differ slightly from the above, as the cost categories are determined by applying the following variables:

- Envelopes, Printing and Postage, and WAEC Costs are determined by the number of electors in your Local Government;
- Processing and Results is determined by the expected response rate for your election; and
- Returning Officer Costs are determined by the complexity of the election for the Returning Officer; we classify Local Governments into bands depending on a number of factors including number of Wards, number of vacancies and the number of candidates, and then we pay our Returning Officers a rate which reflects this band.

#### Estimated Cost of 2025 Local Government Elections

The Commission estimates that the total cost of conducting the Local Government Elections across Western Australia in 2025 will increase by \$1.3 million, compared to 2023. The key drivers for this cost increase are as follows:

- a 45% cost increase from Australia Post, comprising of a 25% increase which came into effect in March 2024, and an additional 20% proposed increase currently being considered by the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission, which if approved will take effect in July 2025;
- a 9% increase in the salaries paid to Returning Officers as required by the Public Sector CSA Agreement 2024.

#### Variations to the final costs for your Council

In accordance with the *Local Government (Elections) Regulations 1997*, the Commission conducts elections on the basis of full accrual cost recovery. This means that should the actual costs incurred to conduct the election be less or greater than what we have estimated, the final cost may differ from the cost estimate you have been provided.

Whilst we aim to keep additional costs at a minimum wherever possible, the following are examples of where cost increases may arise:

- If a Returning Officer is selected that is not local to your area;
- If you elect for Australia Post Priority Service for the lodgement of your election package;
- If casual staff are required for the issuing of Replacement Election Packages;
- If casual staff are required to assist the Returning Officer on election day or night; or
- Unanticipated cost increases from our suppliers.

We will endeavour to keep you informed of any unanticipated cost increases as they are incurred during the election.

#### Service Commitment

The Commission is committed to conducting elections impartially, effectively, efficiently and professionally. Following each election event, we review our performance and identify ways to improve our service delivery.

The Commission acknowledges that during the 2023 Local Government Ordinary Elections, the results for many Local Governments were delayed. Since this time we have improved our Count Processes, and as demonstrated through extraordinary elections conducted in 2024, we are now able to finalise our results more quickly whilst still retaining accuracy and integrity.

If you have any suggestions for improvements we can make to deliver your election, your feedback is welcome at all times.

#### **Next Steps**

Should you wish to accept this cost estimate and proceed with the Electoral Commission undertaking this election, there are specific steps that must be taken under the *Local Government Act 1995*. These steps are summarised in the attached flow chart (Attachment A).

As outlined in the flow chart, if you accept this Cost Estimate then please advise of us this in writing, so that we can issue a Written Agreement letter. Both the Cost Estimate letter, and the Written Agreement letter then need to be taken to Council for a decision.



#### Written Agreement: 2025 Local Government Ordinary Election

I refer to your correspondence dated [date] in which you accept the Western Australian Electoral Commission's Cost Estimate for the 2025 Local Government Ordinary Election, as outlined in my letter to you dated 12 December 2024 (the Cost Estimates Letter).

### A. BACKGROUND / DETAILS

In accordance with the Recognition of High Achievers Policy adopted by Council in April 2024 (refer Attachment 13.1.2.1), the panel for selecting inductees into the Walk of Fame is to consist of:

- Shire President (Deputy President in the absence of the President).
- Shire of Northam Chief Executive Officer.
- An independent community member, selected from a group of volunteers, through and expression of interest (EOI) process, with final decision made by Council.

Expressions of Interest were sought via a public callout between 6 and 20 December 2024, with a total of 11 nominations received. Details of the nominees are provided in confidential Attachment 13.1.2.2.

It is noted that in previous considerations regarding the Walk of Fame selection panel, there was discussion regarding the Shire of Northam Australia Day Citizen of the Year being encouraged to nominate for the community member position. A review of the selection process for the Shire's Australia Day Citizen Awards will be undertaken in coming months and through this review, it is possible to consider how the Citizen of the Year may be involved on future selection panels for the Walk of Fame and/or Australia Day Citizen Awards.

The EOI for the community member has been based on the Walk of Fame selection panel members volunteering their time and as such, there is not anticipated to be any financial implication in this regard.



From quotes sourced on plinths/plaques in the design agreed upon following discussions with Council Members on 27 November 2024, it is estimated that each plinth/plaque for the Walk of Fame will be \$1,000.

Based on an available budget of \$5,000 in 2024/25, this provides for 5 inductees in the first year of the program, or 4 inductees and an introductory plaque at the beginning of the Walk of Fame.

### C. OFFICER'S COMMENT

There were 11 nominations received in response to the EOI for a community member for the Walk of Fame selection panel. Based on the existing Policy,



Council is required to select one community panel member. Given there is more than one nomination received, the Chief Executive Officer will facilitate a ballot process to determine the successful community member based on the votes of Council Members.

It is recognised that given the level of interest, Council may wish to consider appointing more than one community member to the selection panel. If this is the case, Council would first need to resolve to amend the Recognition of High Achievers Policy to provide for an increase in the number of community members on the selection panel and then undertake the ballot process to determine the successful nominees.

It is suggested that appointed community representatives on the panel will serve a term of 3 years, unless during occupation of the role, they move outside of the Shire of Northam or are otherwise unable to complete the full 3-year term.

#### **Recognition Approach**

There will be two ways in which the High Achievers will be recognised - via a digital kiosk and / or Walk of Fame.

#### Digital Kiosk

Initially one digital kiosk will house information about the High Achievers and be available in a central location within the Shire. The digital kiosk will be interactive and designed to provide easy access to information in digital form related to the High Achievers.

#### Walk of Fame

In line with the Shire's Streetscape Plan, the Walk of Fame will typically consist of a plaque or paver, including a brief history which will be inserted within the path or wall to commemorate a high achiever.


