A 8.2 Policy for Children on a Fire Ground

POLICY Volunteer Fire fighters under 16 years of age should not be

on the fire ground unless accompanied by and under the

direction of their parent or their employer.

Volunteer Fire fighters aged 16 or 17 years of age should be

accompanied by and under the direction of a parent or

guardian when on the fire ground.

OBJECTIVES To minimise risk.
