#### 6.5 CONSIDERATION/APPROVAL OF PROVENANCE CARD FORMAT

The committee noted that Council has endorsed the design of the provenance cards and made a provision of \$500.00 in the 2013/2014 budget for the cards to be prepared and laminated. It was also noted that Council endorsed that Mrs Letch complete the works quoted once the 2013/2014 budget has been adopted.

Now that the budget has been adopted Mrs Letch can be contacted to arrange a time frame and the necessary paperwork can be completed.

Mr Letch returned to the meeting room at 4.16pm.

Mr Letch suggested that we could contact the Northam RSL in regards to the description for the Hugo Throssell provenance card. Ms Gobbart suggested that we could use pamphlets to create the card and ask the Northam RSL to review and provide any suggestions in regards to the cards improvement.

#### 6.6 ART STORAGE DESIGN

The committee noted that building services have been advised that these works can proceed now that the 2013/2014 Budget has been adopted.

#### 6.7 REPRODUCTION'S OF HUGO THROSSELL PORTRAIT

The committee has acknowledged that the Australian Was Memorial will not pursue acquiring a reproduction of the Hugo Throssell portrait as per their letter received on 6 August 2013.

It was bought the committee attention that at this stage there is no hanging area for the Council's reproduction of the Hugo Throssell portrait. It was suggested that this copy could be displayed in other buildings and lent to community groups.

It was raised that now the painting is on display, as part of Council's decision to display the painting at the Northam Visitor Centre, it was decided that a shield should be placed over the painting for protection, Cr Beresford asked the question if it needed a protective barrier as it is located quite high on the wall. It was raised that if the committee felt that the portrait did not require a protective barrier they would need to make a recommendation to Council.

Cr Beresford suggested that a Perspex shield could be placed over the painting which would stand off from the wall.
