

## TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLANS (Events)



### OVERVIEW

This information sheet has been prepared to provide a brief overview of Traffic Management requirements for events being held on or near State and Local roads, as outlined in the *Code of Practice—Traffic Management for Events*

### EVENT CATEGORIES

Both on-road and off-road events have the potential to directly or indirectly impact road users. To determine the need for a Traffic Management Plan (TMP), events types have been separated into 6 general categories. A description of these categories with examples are outlined in *Code of Practice—(Table 1—Categories' of Events)*

### TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLANS

#### General

Depending on the event category type there are various levels of approval required which may include submissions to some or all of the following stakeholders;

- Western Australia Police
- Main Roads Western Australia
- Local Government Authority

#### TMP Preparation

Generic Traffic Management Plans are provided in the *Code of Practice—Appendix 4* which can be used for Category 2,3 and 6 events, provided they are selected and implemented in accordance with the requirements outlined in *Section 7.2* of the Code of Practice.

#### TMP Preparation (Cont.)

Any event involving complex traffic arrangements must be prepared by a person holding an Advanced Worksite Traffic management Accreditation. Examples of complex traffic arrangements can be found in *Section 7.3 of the Code of Practice*.

#### Timeframes

In accordance with the *Road Traffic Regulation No. 7* Timeframes for the submission of traffic management applications prior to the event are as follows;

- Category 1                      6 Months
- Category 2                      3 Months
- Category 3 & 4                1 Month
- Category 5                      4 days
- Category 6                      6 Weeks
